Notice of Race

The Organizing Authority for the 2020 KBYC ILCA Series is the Key Biscayne Yacht Club (KBYC), ILCA fleet and coaches.

1 RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 Laser, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7 competitors who are members of the ILCA-North America or their National Laser Class Association may enter by completing the registration and paying the required fees.

3 REGISTRATION

3.1 Competitors shall register via website www.kbyc.org.

4 EVENT FORMAT

This is a Parent / Coach Regatta that means this people are running the regatta just for practice. Parents are running start and finish and coaches are running the race course.

Coaches are allowed to talk with their sailors during the race but can not interrupt any other sailor in the race course.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1 Saturday

12:00h – Races (Fullrig, Radial & 4.7 in sequence)

Sunday

11:00h – Races (Fullrig, Radial & 4.7 in sequence)

5.2 No more than three races per fleet will be scheduled for each day, except if there's no races on Saturday. In this case the maximum of races Sunday are 5 races.

5.3 No warning signal will be made after 15:00h on Sunday.

5.4 A total of 6 races are scheduled, of which a minimum of two (2) races must be completed to constitute a Serie.

5.5 If less than 5 boats are in the same fleet, they will start together with another fleet. (example: if we have 4 fullrigs we will have them with the Radial at the same start)

6 VENUE

The Racing area will be in Biscayne Bay.

7 COURSES

The courses will be Trapezoid (inner & outer loop) or Windward / Leeward (two laps).

8 SCORING.

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.

8.2 When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8.3 There will be Class Scoring (Standard / Radial / 4.7) for Trophies in the end of the Total Series (Fall and Spring).

9 SUPPORT BOATS

Race Committee boats will fly a Race Committee "RC" flag or an Official Orange flag.

10 ADMINISTRATIVE

Competitors will be welcome to arrive at the Key Biscayne Yacht Club on Fridays or Saturday before each Series if needed.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

All boats can have a VHF. Communication will be in channel 72.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
